## **Village of Herrings**

Rt 3 (Proposed as Alternative Byway Route Loop)

Resources are located between NYS DOT Start/End Mile Point Jefferson County 12.49 to 15.32

Located in northern Jefferson County in the Town of Wilna along the scenic and natural resource of the Black River on Route 3, the village developed around its bountiful natural resources of wood and water. Strategically located between the villages of Carthage and Deferiet, Herrings is named after William P. and Fred M. Herrings owners of the paper mill located in Herrings around the turn of the 20<sup>th</sup> century.

Once a rest area for travelers traversing Route 3 by stagecoach over 100 years ago, the Herrings Inn remains a privately owned and managed establishment serving as a respite to visitors offering food and lodging. Located along the scenic and natural resource of the Black River, it maybe the smallest incorporated village in New York State with approximately 150 residents. Today the village serves as a bedroom community to neighboring communities today.
