




Disaster Definition




River Road North View






The Snow Came

Safety

Public Health POD for inoculations

Boil Water still in effect for all wells

Permanent barricades placed by National Guard

Fire and Ambulance zones reworked for flooded/damaged roads.

Aerial flights completed all homes isolated have been contacted or evacuated.

River Road damaged assessment still underway.

E Main St. bridge in Your Village impassible due to debris damage and footer washout.

St. Rt. 12 South of Lock still damaged traffic flowing well 12D-St. Rt. 26.

Your Village Elementary codes inspection done, building sound will reopen after door repair and cleaning of mud & debris.

Infrastructure

Water still arriving at Big Business Mfg. will need closer distribution point for drop off, All Textile warehouse in Your Village (will need cleaning)

Food MRE's due Wednesday and comfort kits for displaced, warehouse needed.

Logistics

Larger truck may be needed to move and distribute water to villages.

More volunteers are needed for distribution of donated goods.

Town of Riverdale reports low fuel at town barn. Vendor requesting payment before next delivery, (\$23,000). May need skid tank to continue operations.

Finance

County Highway reports \$3600 additional in overtime projected 2 week cleanup and repair to villages requesting overtime increase to \$12,000 to cover. Assistance focused in Leyden, Riverdale and West Village. Providing backfill for daily operations.

Leydens burden lessoned by village contract with Truck-R-Buddy (they have sub-contracted additional to assist in cleanup).

Finance Cont.

Governor has toured area this is classified as a "local" disaster projections currently at 24 million short of 26 million required for FEMA assistance. State has assured dedicated resources and further assistance is forthcoming though no specifics have been given.

SBA has interviewed some families and have offices set up in the Storefront plaza in Your Village

Those who qualify for flood insurance may not receive benefit if FEMA doesn't declare an aerial disaster.
